DYNAMIC AREA REGULATION

A Admission Access and Return

- 1) All companies exhibiting at EIMA International, manufacturers of machinery and equipment relevant to the biomass sector, are admitted to the dynamic area of the EIMA Energy exhibition.
- 2) The organiser will make an irrevocable decision on the acceptance of applications, in absolute independence.
- 3) The organiser shall be entitled to change the layout of the demonstration area at any time due to technical operational requirements and unforeseeable or force majeure circumstances.
- 4) The participation fee only covers the costs of organising and setting up the dynamic area. The fee is set at € 2,500 per company and is subject to change, which will be notified to participants in good time, should these costs vary substantially.
- 5) The area that will be allocated to each participant will take into account the machines that will be used for the tests and the space available in order to satisfy all requests.
- 6) Companies wishing to participate in the demonstrations may position their machines and equipment from 8:00 on Monday 7 November and must complete these operations by 12:00 on Tuesday 8 November. Exhibiting companies must vacate the occupied spaces by 20:00 on 15 November.

B Organisation of demonstrations

- 1) The organiser, in cooperation with ITABIA - ITALIAN BIOMASS ASSOCIATION and CNR-IBE, will manage the following points:
 - organisation and planning of the demonstration;
 - demarcation and marking of test areas;
 - allocation of test areas to demonstrators;
 - conducting guided tours.
- 2) The visits will be coordinated by experts from CNR-IBE, who will provide a detailed explanation of the operation of the machines as agreed with the participating companies.
- 3) The organiser will provide a suitable security service for the night.
- 4) At the request of the exhibiting companies, machines and equipment may be put into operation outside the hours set for demonstrations, if necessary, subject to authorisation by the organiser and CNR-IBE.
- 5) A Pocket Theme Salon with names and locations of participating companies will be produced and attached to the Eima 2022 general catalogue and distributed to visitors at the various Info Points.

C Insurance and security

- 1) Demonstrations must be carried out by personnel qualified to operate the machines and equipment. Companies that allow visitors to try out one or more machines or equipment will do so under their own responsibility.
- 2) Each company taking part in the demonstrations shall be obliged to take out an individual insurance policy to cover third party liability risks (RCT) arising from the demonstration activity, with a limit of indemnity appropriate to the nature of the potential risk involved in relation to each machine presented, and send a copy to FederUnacoma Surl.
- 3) Each company participating in the demonstrations must submit its own 'operational safety plan'.
- 4) Machines, systems, equipment and appliances to be exhibited must comply with accident prevention regulations and any other legislative, regulatory and good technical prescriptions, and must be accompanied by the prescribed administrative documentation of the competent Authorities. The Exhibitor shall bear all criminal and civil liability for any injuries and/or damages that may be caused to third parties as a consequence of the non-observance or violation of the aforesaid standards and/or instructions.
- 5) Operators operating the machines and persons supporting them who are engaged in demonstration activities must wear the personal protective equipment (PPE) provided for the performance of such activities.
- 6) All work stations will be appropriately cordoned off. The delimitation will be carried out in such a way as to keep the public out of the danger zone. During demonstrations, public access within the safety perimeter is prohibited, while it is permitted when demonstrations are suspended, always under the direct responsibility of the exhibitor. The exhibitor undertakes as of now to comply with all safety regulations in order to avoid any accidents, for which he shall in any case remain solely responsible.
- 7) When the machines are not in use, they must be parked safely and in such a way that they do not obstruct the public or other operators.

- 1)** It will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to procure the materials used for demonstrations (wood, pellets, etc.) and to store them in the vicinity of their work area.
- 2)** It will be the responsibility of the CNR-IBE to agree, in good time, with the exhibiting companies on the quantities of materials (wood pellets etc.) required for the demonstration tests.
- 3)** It will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to remove unused and processed material at the end of the event.

These regulations are deemed to have been seen and accepted by the demonstrating companies and must be forwarded to the Organising Secretariat, duly signed for acceptance.
